About Destination- Saadani National Park

Saadani national park is 13th largest national park in Tanzania, its only national park where a bush meets with Indian Ocean. Its only national park too closes with dare s salaam city by distance (only 2h30) from city centre.

By passing Makurunge village to the rough road going Pangani Tanga, it will give you best moment in this road while you watching daily village life, more over you will see largest sugarcane plantations farm from the richest Said Salim Bakhressa. Its only 44kilometres you will be arrive at gama gate and from there you will cross a Wami River and entering into the park.

Wami River is the 3rd largest river in Tanzania after Rufiji River and great RuahaRiver. Wami River crossing in the park and mouthed in an indian ocean at southern of national park. Wami River is the home of crocodiles and hippopotamuses and large group of aquatics birds. Mangrove forest along the Wami River is the second largest mangrove forest after Rufiji mangrove and this will give you a time better inside the park.

Saadani national park gazette in 2005 and connected with 3 districts Chalinze, Bagamoyo and Pangani and inside the park there is some village where a people settled. Saadani national park is the home of elephants, buffaloes, lions, leopard, giraffes, impalas, gnu, zebra, eland, dik-dik, common waterbuck, bush buck and many more to mention.

Saadani national park will gives you opportunities of swimming in an Indian ocean because its bordered with it, even all accommodation and campsite is the ocean view sightseeing.

Tipping Policy:

- ✓ Chef/Cook's \$5-US\$10 per guest, per day

For hotels/lodges/tented camps, please do not tip individual staff members, but instead use

the 'Tip Box' which you should -find at the reception of your accommodation. For guidance, you should consider tipping between US \$2 - US\$ 5 per day, per guest, at each accommodation.

Note:

What we have indicated is just an overview of how you can do it. This shouldn't in anyhow limit you since tipping indicates how professional they were and had your best interests in mind. You can choose to go beyond that as per your ability and satisfaction.
