## About Destination- Mount Kilimanjaro

**Mount Kilimanjaro** (/ˌkɪlmənˈdʒɑːroʊ/) is a dormant volcano in Tanzania. It has three volcanic cones: Kibo, Mawenzi, and Shira. It is the highest mountain in Africa and the highest single free-standing mountain above sea level in the world: 5,895 metres (19,341 ft) above sea level and about 4,900 metres (16,100 ft) above its plateau base. It is the highest volcano in Africa and the Eastern Hemisphere.

Kilimanjaro is the fourth most topographically prominent peak on Earth. It is part of Kilimanjaro National Park and is a major hiking and climbing destination. Because of its shrinking glaciers and ice fields, which are projected to disappear between 2025 and 2035, it has been the subject of many scientific studies.

### Highlights:

*Large animals are rare on Kilimanjaro and are more frequent in the forests and lower parts of the mountain. Elephants and Cape buffaloes are among the animals that can be potentially hazardous to trekkers. Bushbucks, chameleons, dik-diks, duikers, mongooses, sunbirds, and warthogs have also been reported. Zebras, leopards and hyenas have been observed sporadically on the Shira plateau. Specific species associated with the mountain include the Kilimanjaro shrew and the chameleon Kinyongia tavetana.*

**Arrival day** – Kilimanjaro Airport/ Arusha Airport, where you will be greeted by Mountain guide. Drive to your Hotel, Moshi or Arusha. Depending on your arrival time have a guided walk through Moshi/Arusha Briefing in evening for your climb starting the next day.

**Day 1 Marangu Gate - Mandara Hut** You will be picked up at your hotel in Moshi and driven to Marangu Gate. When your guide is done dealing with all the registration forms you can start your climbing adventure! Dinner and overnight at Mandara Hut.

## Day 2 Mandara Hut - Horombo Hut

- ✓ Dinner and overnight at Horombo Hut. 3 meals included
- ✓ Mandara Hut (2720m) to Horombo Hut (3720m)
- ✓ Hike time: 5-6 hours



**Day 3 Horombo Hut - Kibo Hut** There is no running water at Kibo Hut. The remainder of the day is spent relaxing in preparation for the final ascent before a very early night.

- ✓ Horombo Hut (3720m) to Kibo Hut (4700 m)
- ✓ Hike time: 4-6 hours

**Day 4 Kibo Hut - Uhuru Peak - Horombo Hut** Wake up before midnight in the cover of darkness. We begin a steep climb over loose volcanic screen has some well-graded zig-zags and a slow but steady pace will take us to rim of the main crater, Gillman's 5685 m. There you can rest for a few minutes to enjoy the sunrise over Mawenzi. Those who are still feeling good can continue slowly to make the three hour

round trip from here along the crater rim to Uhuru peak 5895 m which is the highest point in Africa. After a few minutes to appreciate your accomplishment descend to reach Horombo Hut.

**Day 5 Horombo Hut - Marangu Gate – Arusha** Today you will descend all the way down to Marangu Gate. Successful climbers will receive their summit certificates. At the gate you will be driven back to Arusha for your celebration and overnight at your Lodge

#### What to expect when climbing Mt Kilimanjaro

Before you embark on your trekking adventure, you will meet with our Trekking Operations Manager for an extensive briefing. Route, safety procedures and health issues will be discussed in detail and you have enough time to ask any remaining questions. Your trekking gear will be inspected to ensure that you have everything you need to be safe and comfortable. If you are missing any gear, you can rent it from us. During your climb, you only carry your backpack with essentials such as water for the day's hike. Our porters will carry all equipment, food and additional luggage – they are tough climbers and the true heroes of the mountain.

Our permanent mountain guides will lead the way. They are responsible for your safety and will encourage you and lend a helping hand, but also call the climb off due to weather, altitude sickness or injury, if necessary. Your safety is paramount to us. Most of our mountain guides have been part of our team for many years, been up Kilimanjaro hundreds of times and all receive regular training. You are in good hands.

Our cooks are miracle workers. With simple gas cookers, they conjure up 3-course feasts, hot drinks and snacks to revive and nourish you when you need it most. Drinking water comes from mountain streams and is boiled before you drink it.

On most routes, you will sleep in high-quality two-person tents. The tents will be pitched and taken down by our team of porters. You can concentrate on getting to the top, one step at a time. When you arrive at camp after a long day's hike, your tent will already be waiting for you. Our camping gear is highest standard. It is inspected and cleaned regularly by our equipment team in Arusha.

## **Tipping Policy:**

Tipping is of course discretionary, but is an expected part of the way in which business is done in Tanzania. It counts as an expression of gratitude to those who – hopefully – have made your experience an unforgettable one, and enables you to directly reward those people. Our passengers come from all around the world, with different cultural attitudes to tipping, but a tip is of great significance here in Tanzania and will be hugely appreciated by the recipient.
